# Live

This guide shows you how to set up the D400 in Live. All pictures provided were taken with Live 9 but it is also applicable to most other Live versions.

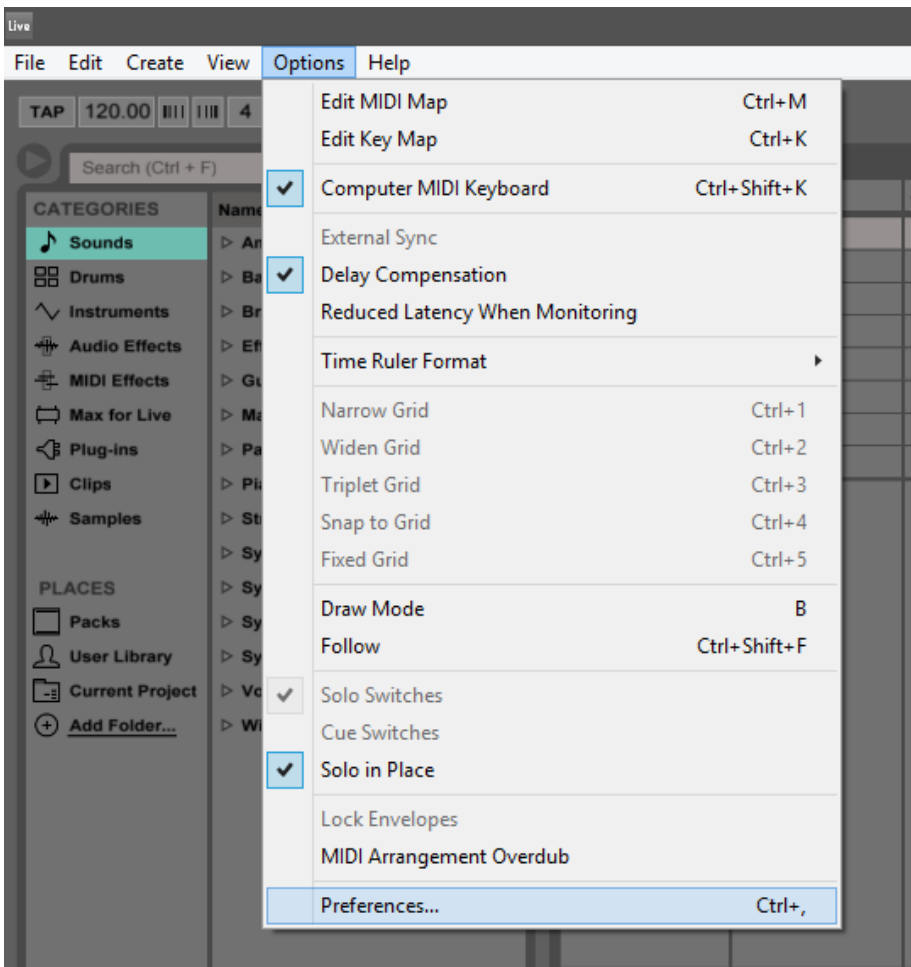
## Step 1:

- Select the Live preset

*How to select a preset is described in the main manual.*

## Step 2:

- Open Live
- Click on **Options->Preferences...**



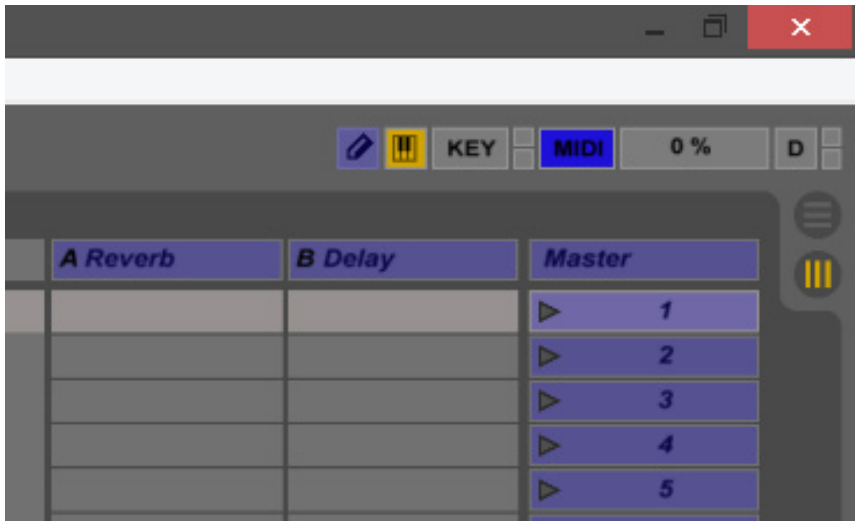
### Step 3:

- Set everything as shown below. This enables all main features like faders etc.



## Step 4: (optional)

- To use all keys, you have to set them up first. To do this click on **MIDI**

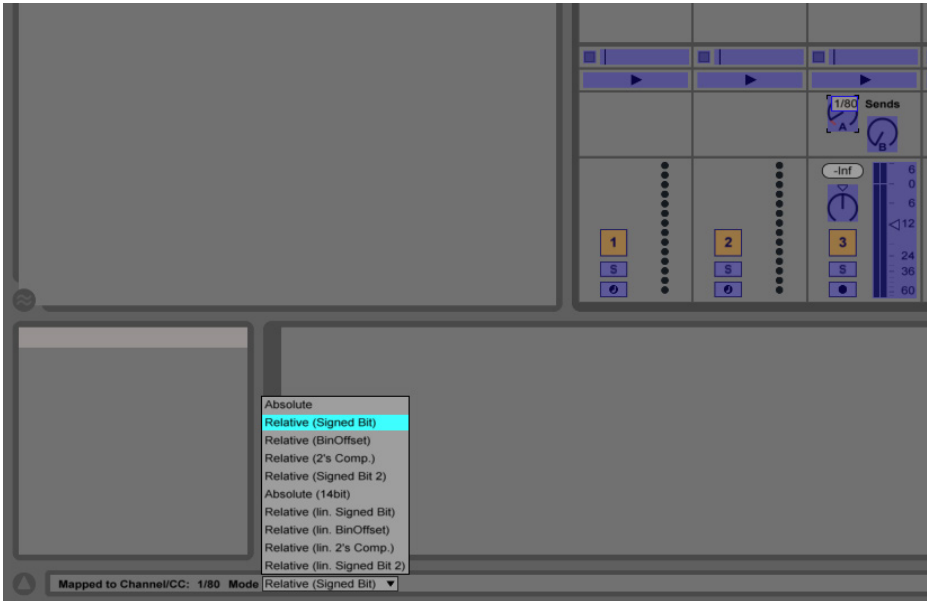


- Now you can click on a blue area. This will select the underlying control. After that press a key on the D400. This will assign that key to the selected control. Press **MIDI** again to save

*If you are having trouble with this, you should have a look at the manual of your DAW.*

## Step 5: (optional)

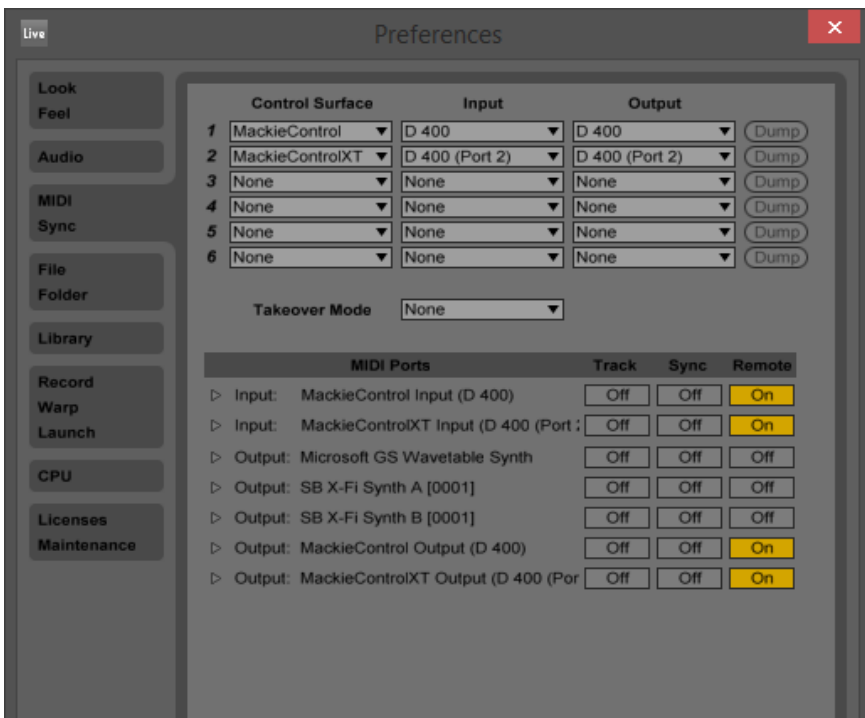
- If you would like to assign an encoder to a control in Live, it works the same way as assigning a button but you should make sure to select **Relative (Signed Bit)** in the lower left corner



## Step 6: (optional)

- If you want to connect more than one extension, you should redo step 3 but select **D400 (Port 2)** as MIDI Input and as MIDI Output and **Mackie Control XT**

*If there is only one D400 showing up, you need to enable the extensions first. How you can do that is described in the main manual.*
